Parade Rules:

- 1) All candy must be thrown to the curb and not into the street. Material handouts must be distributed by walkers on the side. Distribution of items should be organized, so that units are not slowed or cause gaps in the parade.
- 2) No animal pickup is provided, so please cleanup after your animals.
- 3) Alcohol is prohibited in all parade areas.
- 4) In the event of rain, the parade will proceed. If it is lightning and thundering, please check our Facebook page (New London Water Days) or tune into Q102 (102.5fm) to hear if the parade has been canceled or postponed. If the parade is canceled, your entry fee will not be returned and will become a donation to the festivities.
